(Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation)

What Is It?

BALOO is a one-day course designed to teach Pack parents and new Cub Scouts leaders with minimal camping experience how to plan and carry out an entry-level outdoor experience for the pack. Completion of this course will result in increased confidence and a willingness to plan a pack campout. This training is the first step in the BSA camping program and does not replace any existing training.

Specific Objectives of the Course

- 1) Help participants gain an understanding of the BSA camping program.
- 2) Help participants acquire the skills and confidence necessary to plan and carry out a successful, first time Cub Scout level camping activity.
- 3) Increase a participant's knowledge of the resources available from the BSA and other sources to carry out this activity.
- 4) Enable the participant to understand the requirement for successful completion of this activity, using national standards as guidelines.

Specific Course Information

The course will be offered at Maumee Scout Reservation on **Saturday, October 23rd and Saturday, May 14th at 9:00 am to approximately 4:00 pm. Registration begins at 8:30 am.
